Why BIM?


Industry Challenge

- More efficient communication
- Fragmented Information
- Lack in total visibility
- Documentation defects




Results...

- "The cumulative effect of the current model produces buildings that cost almost twice as much as they should ... [and] that create 48% of carbon dioxide emissions ..."
- 72% of projects are completed over budget
- 70% are completed behind schedule
- 75% of those late projects are at least 50% over initial contract price.
- Construction workers are 2 ½ times as likely to die compared to other



Results – productivity in United States






What BIM could help?

BIM innovate a new workflow (Source: Pike Research)




What is BIM
