

HKIBIM Assessment Criteria

(Endorsed by the Board and posted on HKIBIM web)

Associate Membership - 附屬會員 (AMHKIBIM)

- Certificate or above in relation to BIM which the course shall be organized/taught by a Professional member of HKIBIM (MHKIBIM) and recognized by the Board from time to time; **AND minimum 1 year of experience in BIM application or management** as recognized by the Board from time to time;
- Minimum 1 year of BIM working experience includes planning, designing, administrating and operating of BIM projects, counting prior to the submission of application form;
- Portfolio of project(s) to be submitted;
- Proof of BIM courses attended, including in-house training, short BIM courses;
- Fee: HK\$300 (annual).

Professional Membership - 專業會員 (MHKIBIM)

- **Degree** or above in relation to Building, Construction and Engineering, or as recognized by the Board from time to time; **AND minimum 2 years of experience in BIM application or management** as recognized by the Board from time to time;
- **Minimum 2 years of BIM working experience** includes planning, designing, administrating and operating of BIM projects, counting prior to the submission of application form;
- Portfolio of project(s) to be submitted;
- Proof of BIM courses attended, including in-house training, short BIM courses, and degree courses;
- Passing an interview offered by the institute;
- Fee: HK\$500 (annual).
