Overview of ESH

3

- Establish a central hub to allow on-line e-submissions by the public, e-referrals to Centralized Processing System (CPS) participants and e-approval of the applications under Buildings Ordinance
- Allow communication and processing of building development related submission under other departments/authorities
- Allow the self-service tracking of application process
- Integrate the existing Electronic Form Submission System with the new ESH
- Facilitate the use of BIM (one of the acceptable electronic submission formats) by the building professionals for plan submission
- Develop computer-aided plan-checking facilities to improve efficiencies of plan approval processes

BD's Tentative Implementation Plan of ESH

- Launch ESH for accepting plan submissions / applications electronically and referral to 36 Departments / Authorities in 3 stages starting from **mid-2021 to 2026**

2017 Policy Address (para 113)

Construction and Related Professional Services Sectors

From 2018, adopt BIM technology in the design and construction of major government capital works projects and promote the use of this technology in private construction projects.

2018 Budget(para 115)

Construction Innovation and Technology Fund

\$1 billion Construction Innovation and Technology Fund to boost the construction industry to adopt new technology. Financial support to acquire the software and hardware, nurture the expertise required such as BIM, to receive training for students and practitioners.

- **PNAP ADM-19 - Use of AutoCAD for floor area calculation in GBP submission**
 - Submitted in DVD-rom
 - Standard format / file name / diagram layers / presentation style

- **PNAP ADV-34 - Acceptance of BIM as supplementary information for plan submissions**
 - Submitted in DVD-rom
 - BIM viewing software for free download
 - Examples: Innovative building design, complex drainage/superstructure, sequence and phasing of works

BD's Tentative Implementation Plan of BIM

7

- Accept BIM submissions (**GBP only**) for mathematical calculations to facilitate verification and checking area calculation under the Buildings Ordinance in **early / mid-2019**
- Cover diagrammatic breakdown and details on calculation of the GFA, UFA, site coverage, plot ratio, refuge floor area, site coverage of greenery, etc.
- Revise PNAP ADM-19 - define the standard submission requirements
